KA131 - learning mobility in the field of higher education

Trakia University is opening a second session for the recruitment of students, PhD candidates, and medical residents for participation in mobility programs for the academic year 2024-2025 under the Erasmus+ program, KA131 – learning mobility in the field of higher education

Students and PhD candidates wishing to participate in mobility for study or traineeships can apply if they are regular or part-time students (Bachelor's or Master's level) who have successfully completed their first year at Trakia University, as well as PhD candidates and medical residents at Trakia University.

Students must have an overall academic success rating of "Good."
All candidates must have a very good command of the language in which the training or study will be conducted in the host country.

More than one participation in the Erasmus+ program is allowed, but the total duration of completed and planned mobilities must not exceed 12 months within the same level of study.

Students who wish to complete a traineeship within one year after successful graduation (after passing all state exams or defending their thesis project) must submit their documents by the specified deadlines and be selected while still registered as students (before taking state exams or defending their thesis project).

The deadline for submitting online application forms is October 27, 2024.

The selection of candidates will be conducted in strict compliance with the selection criteria outlined in the Rules for the Organization of Activities under the Erasmus+ Program at Trakia University. The list of ranked candidates, summarized and approved at the university level, will be published on the Trakia University website.

Approved candidates for participation in the mobilities will receive a non-repayable financial grant to help cover their travel, daily allowances, accommodation, insurance, and other expenses.
